

## **Environmental Projects:**

- Environmental Services, 1833-J Rock Chapel Road, Lithonia, Georgia 30058, contact: Curvature Landscapes installed (3000), one-gallon container wetland shrubs along a stream corridor. The mitigation project was at the Lon Golf Club in Bremen, Georgia. We had a crew of (14) people working two days. The survival rate for the plant material is greater than 95%.
